It is our request that children not participate in the Lord's Supper until they themselves have become communing members of such church. We come not as those who are intrinsically righteous, but as those who have been given through grace the righteousness of our perfect Redeemer. So, while we repent of known sin as we come, we recognize our standing before the Father is completely dependent on the accomplishment of Jesus Christ for His people.
