Minister: Lift up your hearts!


People: We lift them up to the Lord!

Scripture Reading: Psalm 117 (*one person read the scripture aloud*)

Questions for Discussion (*may be answered in one worship time, or spread over several times*)

2. What words would you use to praise the Lord?
3. In addition to using our mouths to speak or sing God's praise, what are some other ways we can praise the Lord?
4. What is steadfast love? (verse two)
5. Look up the word "endures" in a concordance. What other things besides the Lord's faithfulness will endure forever?
6. Verse one of Psalm 117 tells all the nations to praise the Lord. Who would you like to invite to praise the Lord?
