



#### \*The Scripture Reading: John 17.1-26

When Jesus had spoken these words, He lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son that the Son may glorify You,

- <sup>2</sup> since You have given Him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom You have given Him.
- <sup>3</sup> And this is eternal life, that they know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
- <sup>4</sup> I glorified You on earth, having accomplished the work that You gave Me to do.
- <sup>5</sup> And now, Father, glorify Me in Your own presence with the glory that I had with You before the world existed.
- <sup>6</sup> I have manifested Your name to the people whom You gave me out of the world. Yours they were, and You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your Word.
- <sup>7</sup> Now they know that everything that You have given Me is from You.
- <sup>8</sup> For I have given them the words that You gave Me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from You; and they have believed that You sent Me.

- <sup>9</sup> I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours.
- <sup>10</sup> All Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them.
- <sup>11</sup> And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to You. Holy Father, keep them in Your name, which You have given Me, that they may be one, even as We are one.
- While I was with them, I kept them in Your name, which You have given Me. I have guarded them, and not one of them has been lost except the son of destruction, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.
- <sup>13</sup> But now I am coming to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.
- <sup>14</sup> I have given them Your Word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
- <sup>15</sup> I do not ask that You take them out of the world, but that You keep them from the evil one.
- <sup>16</sup> They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
- <sup>17</sup> Sanctify them in the truth; Your Word is truth.
- <sup>18</sup> As You sent Me into the world, so I have sent them into the world.
- <sup>19</sup> And for their sake I consecrate Myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth.
- <sup>20</sup> "I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word,
- <sup>21</sup> that they may all be one, just as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You have sent Me.
- <sup>22</sup> The glory that You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one even as We are one,
- <sup>23</sup> I in them and You in Me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that You sent Me and loved them even as You loved Me.
- <sup>24</sup> Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, may be with Me where I am, to see My glory that You have given Me because You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
- <sup>25</sup> O righteous Father, even though the world does not know You, I know You, and these know that You have sent Me.
- <sup>26</sup> I made known to them Your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which You have loved Me may be in them, and I in them."



# Communicants Class Parent Intro Meeting


